

- f) Minutes of all Committee Meetings
- g) Tax Returns
- h) Audited Financial Statements

- k) Investment Statements
- l) Read-only Access to accounting files (i.e., QuickBooks or other accounting software)
- m) Balance Sheets
- n) Profit and Loss Statements
- o) General Ledgers
- p) Supporting Documentation for the General Ledger
- q) Fixed Asset and Depreciation Registers
- r) Account and Reserve Reconciliations
- s) Invoices
- t) Checks
- u) Credit Card Statements
- v) Contracts with Employees (e.g., ARBOR's CEO)
- w) Contracts with Third Parties
- x) Correspondence between the Board Members (other than the meeting minutes)

y) Correspondence between the employees of the corporation and the officers, directors, members, or third parties.
